





Precautions to Help You Reduce Your Risk of Bee & Wasp Stings



Our expert pest management technicians recommend these precautions to help reduce your risk of getting stung by a bee or wasp around your property.

-  Keep children and pets away from the Bees or Wasps
-  Keep the property doors and windows closed
-  If you do go outside, ensure that your arms, legs and feet are covered
-  Do not attempt to interfere with the Bees or Wasps, including provoking, poking, or spraying

Bee and Wasp stings can be painful and result in redness of the skin around the sting, however some people can have allergic reactions that can result in very severe symptoms and even death.

If you think someone who is allergic may have been stung by a bee or wasp or if a person who has been stung has collapsed or is not breathing, call Triple Zero (000) and ask for an ambulance.
